The role of Gamamwe Gallery is to assist, facilitate and encourage creative enthusiasts. We make this possible by putting potential buyers and seller in touch. We will not handle or receive artists physical work, and won't be held responsible for any loss and/or damage.

- No entry will be accepted without fully completed Application Form together with your signature accepting our Terms & Conditions.
- Not all images will be selected for display on our gallery site.
- Those who are successful will be notified by email and their work will be displayed on our website www.gamamwe.com/gallery.
- Each artist whose work is chosen will feature on the website for maximum of 30 days.

1. Your Application must be accompanied by a copy of your artwork in digital format, either photographed or scanned. Each image must accompanied by a separate Application Form.
2. Make sure your image is High Resolution (300dpi) and in JPEG format. The digital file should be a minimum of 2200 pixels and no larger than 6MB
3. Ensure that the image is neatly cropped to show only the artwork
4. Please only send one good quality digital file of your submission.
5. Your JPEG filename should be your surname followed by the title of your work (eg Jones - Rainy Day)
6. Neither 3D images, nor Digital artworks will be accepted.
7. Photographs will be accepted providing they are in printed format, each marked clearly with the appropriate sequence (eg 2/15)

Our focus is to highlight conservation and habitat rehabilitation for the wellbeing of wildlife in general and this is the theme that we encourage. While rural farming and livestock images may be considered, domestic animals such as cats and dogs out of context are unlikely to be chosen.

Sales

- All artworks submitted must be for sale.
 - Our Gamamwe Gallery is an on-line exhibition ONLY and no one should send their physical artwork to us.
 - The sale price, including 25% commission will be set by the artist in US Dolar and should be clearly indicated on the Application Form
 - All artists agree to donate the 25% commission to the conservation efforts of Gamamwe Ranches. (visit www.gamamwe.com/conservation)
 - On sale of the artwork delivery and/or collection charges will be for the artists account.
- In the event of a sale Gamamwe Gallery will liaise directly with the artist and buyer to conclude the contract. It is the artists responsibility to manage the logistics and delivery of the artwork.
